Tournament Rules and Information

Eligibility: The Kegel/ISBPA Midwest Collegiate Classic is a Tier 1 tournament certified by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC) Collegiate Division. As such, it will comply with all USBC rules and regulations, and all participants must be eligible under USBC Collegiate Bowling rules and be able to present a valid USBC membership card upon request.

Divisions: The 2016 KEGEL/ISBPA Midwest Collegiate Classic features competition in Men's Varsity, Women's Varsity, Men's Junior Varsity and Women's Junior Varsity divisions. Any team comprised of mixed gender will compete in the Men's divisions, whether Varsity or Junior Varsity. Varsity teams only are eligible for scholarship prizes based on competition; however, **ALL teams - Varsity and JV - are eligible for additional Lodging Incentive prizes, as described in this brochure.**

Squads: There will be two squads per day – **CHARTRAND** and **DAVIS** - and Men's and Women's teams will be assigned to and compete within a single squad. *The **CHARTRAND "A" SQUAD** will be limited to 60 Varsity and 20 JV teams on a first-come first-served assignment basis. JV teams WILL be allowed to compete on "A" Squad.* Schools may request a preferred squad; every attempt will be made to comply with that request. However, no request should be considered final until the coaches receive confirmation from the Kegel/ISBPA Tournament staff.

Multiple Entries: Entry priority will be given to Varsity teams on a first-come, first-served registration basis. Multiple five-person team entries **WILL** be permitted from the same institution on a lane-availability basis. *JV entries can only be accepted 25 days prior to the start of the tournament* (in this case, December 22, 2015), as described on page 22 of the 2014-15 USBC Collegiate Rulebook, under "Tier 1 Tournaments" (or in the 2015-16 edition when it is posted on bowl.com). **TOURNAMENT MANAGEMENT RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE THE FINAL DECISION TO ENSURE A BALANCED FIELD.**

Entry Deadline: Entries will be processed in order received. A team will be considered confirmed once payment and entry form with team rosters are received. Tournament entries close at 5:00 pm January 8, 2016. **NEW IN 2016: NO REFUNDS ALLOWED AFTER ENTRIES CLOSE.**

Entry Fee: \$225 per team (Lineage - \$150, Expenses - \$75). Entries will be accepted when full payment is received -- University Check, Cashiers Checks and money orders should be made payable to ISBPA. **NEW IN 2016: PAYMENT BY CREDIT CARD WILL BE AVAILABLE.**

Ball Registration: Players will be limited to entering and using five (5) bowling balls during the course of the two-day competition. Coaches will be required to present completed ball registration forms upon check-in and prior to the start of competition on Saturday, January 16.

PLEASE NOTE: There will be **NO** early check-in on the Friday evening prior to the start of the tournament, as in previous years. All teams must check in and present their ball registration forms at the Stardust Bowl Tournament Office (37 E. Lorraine Ave., Addison, Ill. 60101; phone 630-833-1040) on Saturday prior to their starting squad times to receive their official scoresheets and be considered "present" and ready to bowl.

Team Rosters: A team may have a maximum of eight (8) bowlers. This applies to Varsity and Junior Varsity teams alike. A single participant may compete on one and only one team. Teams must bowl with five (5) players on a team. Teams bowling with fewer than five (5) players will receive zero (0) pins for each missing bowler per missed frame.

Substitutions: Only three (3) substitutions may be made per game. A player once removed cannot return to bowl for the remainder of that game.

Attire: Each bowler must wear uniforms that comply with USBC Collegiate Rule 503-Collegiate. All shirts must have a collar and sleeves, similar to golf or polo shirts. Mock turtlenecks with a one-inch collar are acceptable. Men must wear matching slacks, while women must wear matching shorts, skorts, skirts or slacks. No cargo pants or jeans will be permitted.

Tournament Format (REVISED FOR 2016): All teams, whether Varsity or Junior Varsity, will roll FIVE (5) team games Saturday and 20 Baker games Sunday. All scores are scratch, with no bonus pins. Men and women will compete in separate divisions. **Tournament champions will be determined on the basis of total team pinfall for five (5) regular games and 20 Baker games. The top five scorers in the Men's and Women's Varsity divisions, based on total individual pinfall for five (5) games, will be named to All-Tournament teams. Only bowlers competing in the Varsity divisions will be eligible for All-Tournament team selection.**

Lane Assignments: Schools will be assigned a starting lane assignment each day of the competition. Teams with odd lane assignments will skip one pair to the left after each game; teams with even lane assignments will skip one pair to the right after each game.

Lane Conditions: The event will utilize one of Kegel's Sport Patterns. All Kegel Sport Series oil patterns are USBC Sport Bowling compliant, which adhere to ratios of 3:1 or less. The official Tournament Lane Pattern will be announced December 15, 2015 on the Illinois State BPA Web page, <http://bowlillinois.com>.

Scholarships: The Men's and Women's Varsity Champions will each receive a \$1,000 scholarship prize. Four (4) additional scholarship prizes will be awarded in each division, with the value of each prorated on the number of entries in each division.

Additional Rules: Smoking is not allowed within the bowling center at any time as per Illinois state law. Consumption of alcoholic beverages by tournament participants or coaches is not permitted at any time during competition or while in uniform.

Any rule not explicitly covered above will be referred to the 2015-16 USBC Collegiate Rulebook. **ALL OTHER MATTERS WILL BE DECIDED BY THE 2016 KEGEL/ISBPA MIDWEST COLLEGIATE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND ALL DECISIONS OF SAME SHALL BE FINAL.**
